### Marching Band Volunteer Duties

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#### All Chaperones:

- There are many who would like to be involved...be a helper, not a spectator.
- Must agree to participate as assigned.
- Must understand that they are chaperoning the band students, not their family
- Understand that chaperoning is a supervisory/support task – therefore, parents with several small children should plan on volunteering in other capacities. A chaperone's attention is expected to be on their assigned task.
- Help in the stands with water; supervise restroom trips
- Distribute and collect feather plumes
- Help serve and clean up after snack
- Assist as needed on the buses
- Help check buses for trash/lost items
- Work as a team to finish uniform tasks, reorganize for the next event, discard trash (to dumpster)

#### Uniform Crew:

- Will help in issuing, taking up, and hanging uniforms
- Upon arrival at home, goes to uniform room to attend duties

#### Pit Crew:

- Assist student loading crew by maintaining a safe environment to load/unload
- Help move equipment/supplies/water into and out of stadium
- Help move, set up, and break down equipment for halftime performances
- Help monitor our equipment and areas of participation where the band performs

#### Pre-Game Meal:

- Help set up and serve pre game meals for our students
- Clean up after serving meal to students
